Basketball Rules:

8 minute quarters, 5 timeouts per game....three full timeouts and two 30 second timeouts

Clock stops on time outs and free throws

Clock also stops the last two minutes of each half on every whistle

Bonus free throws begin on seventh team foul, double bonus on tenth team foul

Back court will be called in girl's and boy's games. 10 Seconds to cross half court in both boy's and girl's games

No press after a 20 point lead in "A" games

No press after a 10 point lead in "B" games

2 minute overtime periods until tie is broken---1 minute running, last minute stops on all whistles

1 additional time out for overtime.

When in doubt about rules refer to high school rule book

*****New Rule.....A new high school basketball rule has been added for clarification. Players occupying the marked free-throw lane spaces cannot enter the free throw semicircle until the ball touches the rim or the free throw ends....In other words a player cannot box out the shooter until the ball hits the rim or the free throw end. 4:00pm is start time for first game unless coaches agree to an earlier start time. If a team is late warm-up time may be limited.
