GUIDELINES FOR REOPENING OLM SCHOOL AND OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. All employees are being trained on safety protocol.
- 2. All classrooms will be setup so that 6 feet of social distancing can be maintained.
- 3. Restrooms will be sanitized throughout the day.
- 4. Washing hands will be done with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use of hand sanitizer will be used if soap and water are not available. We are adding extra hand washing stations on campus.
- 5. Students from 2nd grade through 8th grade will wear a mask(any color) while inside the classroom. Outdoors they do not need to wear a mask if they social distance.
- 6. Students will each eat lunch in designated areas and/or in the classroom.
- 7. We will still have a hot lunch program, however the lunches will be in boxed containers.
- 8. Chrome books will be assigned and given to every K-8 student.
- 9. Students will be required to have their own supplies(pencils, crayons, scissors, etc..)
- 10. All parents/guardians will wear a mask on school property for meetings.

- 11. Parents will not be admitted on campus or into classrooms prior to or during the school day.
- 12. Students will be dropped off at a predesignated area for proper screening and temperature checks.
- **13.** No volunteers will be on campus until further notice.
- 14. Plexi-glass will be used in some areas of the school.

We are doing the best that we can to open school in a safe manner so that our students and staff are kept safe.

As you know, the COVID-19 situation is evolving and changing on a daily basis. We are preparing to open in person and also virtually. Many things are, and have been put into place to make sure OLM School is ready to educate children.

However, we are already in the planning stages of a virtual auction for the school year. As always, I will make adjustments as needed.
